ADMISSIONS INFORMATION

Calendar: The Spring, 2011 semester will run from late January-mid May, 2011. Applications are due June 1, 2010, and then considered on a rolling basis if space is available.

Admissions criteria: VIS is looking for students in their junior or senior year in 2011 who will take the greatest advantage of an intense academic and intercultural experience in a remote area. This requires motivation, energy, imagination, initiative, the capacity for self-direction and reflection, the ability to work in a team, and strong leadership skills. It is very important that students understand the nature of their commitment to VIS, and our Ladakhi hosts. The application includes written answers to specific questions, two recommendations, a school transcript, and a non-refundable fee of \$100. Official admission is contingent on your physician's approval.

Cost per student: The \$9,500 tuition for the 2011 spring high school semester includes international airfare and covers orientation expenses, preparatory and educational materials; all logistical facilitation; all hotels and guest houses; all meals; all domestic travel expenses abroad; museum, park and temple entrance fees; VIS faculty, instructors and guest lecturers as well as local coordinators and guides; community support/charitable contributions. Applicants from schools that tuition-out may be able to bring one semester of tuition at the announced state average to the VIS semester via The Sharon Academy (TSA), an independent school recognized by the Vermont State Board of Education. In those cases, the projected individual contribution for the semester will be around \$3,250. Students are expected to have their own health insurance, and secondary travel insurance (VIS will provide group rates for secondary insurance).

Expenses not covered by VIS include costs of domestic travel to point of departure (Boston or NYC), inoculations, travel insurance and international medical and evacuation insurance; visa/passport processing fees; personal costs (phone calls/emails, souvenirs, etc.) We recommend that students bring @ \$200-\$250 in personal funds.

Credits: Participants will receive one semester's credit in science, English, history, exhibition/independent study, Ladakhi language and physical education. Credits will be granted by The Sharon Academy. Courses will be taught at the honors/AP level.
